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Please provide a brief description of the project along with its components (attach if additional space is needed): We propose to improve accessibility of trails and picnic areas at the Red Canyon Visitor Center located on the Powell Ranger District, Dixie National Forest. The Red Canyon Visitor Center is situated along Highway 12 and received about 112,000 visitors from April-October, 2009. In 2009 we completed a landscape plan for the visitor center that includes approximately 2,100 feet of accessible trail, picnic area and interpretive displays. Visitors frequent the visitor center throughout the summer season in search of local information, recreation opportunities and a place to stretch out and take break from the road. Red Canyon has a reputation for multiple trail opportunities and a good place for tour buses and other travelers to stop in between destinations. We feel that this project will add to the recreation opportunities that Garfield County and Red Canyon provides.
